

A Visit With PCCC Clubhouse Manager Julie Fulton



Julie Fulton was recently promoted to the position of PCCC Clubhouse Manager. Before moving to Ponca, she worked for 11 years in management at the Sterling Grill in Bartlesville; 5 years as the Evening Manager followed by 6 years as the General Manager.

Your webmaster sat down with Julie recently to learn more about her family and background.

Please tell us about your family.
