Golf Course News



The "dog days" of summer are here and finally the golf course is beginning to fill in. In early spring, I anticipated good coverage and grow-in for our bermuda but that was not the case. We came out of winter a little thin, and it seemed to take forever to get the bermuda growing. All is well now and it is everything we can do to keep it mowed.

As I had talked about before, our weed control in Bermuda was very disappointing to me this spring. We have a pretty solid weed control program in place, but there are so many changing factors that it is difficult to predict the exact outcome. This year was not acceptable and we will continue our efforts to make sure we have a weed free golf course.

We have completed the removal of all dead trees and will soon remove stumps and evaluate replanting.

The blue tee box on hole #14 has always been a troublesome area to maintain quality turf. We are attempting to alter the soil structure and have seeded a blend of bent grass that is normally tolerant of poor soils. Hopefully we will open it back up in about three weeks. Our next project will be working on the right side of #7 green surround.

Ponca City Country Club’s own Michaela Cavener is in her first year on the 2009 Duramed Futures Tour. The Duramed Futures Tour is known as "The Road To The LPGA" and since 1999, it has been designated as the LPGA’s developmental tour. Michaela is currently in 70th place on the money list out of 140 players, with winnings of \$3861.

She has played in 9 professional events so far. Her best finish was a tie for 18th place in the Brownsville, Texas Open with scores of 74-71-76-221. She finished in 38th place in the Texas Hill Country Classic in San Antonio, in 44th place in the Louisiana Pelican Classic in Lafayette, Louisiana and in 56th place in the Impact Invitational at Daytona Beach, Florida. Michaela has missed the cut in 3 events and withdrew from the Duramed Championship in Decatur, Illinois last week with a back injury. She is currently taking two

weeks off while working with her swing coach and will return to the Duramed Tour in early July

The top players on the Duramed Tour this year will qualify to play on the LPGA Tour next year.
